How to Submit a RILM Abstract for a Completed Dissertation

When a dissertation in music has been successfully defended, an abstract of the work should be submitted to RILM (Répertoire Internationale de la Literature Musicale), a central database of music literature. The purpose of the submission is to make new work known to the wider scholarly community, facilitating the exchange of knowledge fundamental to all academic work.

To submit an abstract, follow these steps:

- 1. Go to the RILM U.S. website at <u>http://www.rilm.org/globalNetwork/UnitedStates.html</u>.
- 2. Click on "Author Form" to go to the Submissions page.
- 3. Read through the "guidelines for writing abstracts" (a pdf). Then compose (or edit) your abstract to fit those guidelines.
- 4. Click on "submissions by individuals."
- 5. Click on "create a new account."
- 6. Register yourself in RILM by entering a username and password, along with your email address.
- 7. On the next screen, click on "Create a New Record."
- 8. Fill out the page, choosing "dissertation" for type of document. Click "next."
- Fill out the second page, inserting the abstract in the box indicated. Click, "finalize record."
