Advanced Diploma in Music Theory

The requirements for the ECMS Advanced Diploma include a balance of theory and history, continuous applied lesson enrollment, 2 or 3 years of an ensemble and secondary piano. The Advanced Diploma can be completed in three years but students may elect to complete this diploma over a longer period of time.

It is not possible to complete this course of study in less than 3 years.
