Pre-Collegiate Diploma in Music Theory

The requirements for the ECMS Pre-Collegiate Diploma include a balance of theory and history with 3 years of an ensemble. The Pre-Collegiate Diploma can be completed in five years but students may elect to complete this diploma over a longer period of time.

It is not possible to complete this course of study in less than 5 years.
