

PLACEMENT EXAMINATIONS

Please refer to the online orientation calendar regarding dates and times of placement exams. This calendar will be available on the Eastman website around the first week of August when details have been finalized. GRADUATE PLACEMENT EXAMS

All entering graduate students are required to take placement examinations in music theory and music history before registering for classes. Graduate students starting their degree programs in summer 2008 should contact Deanna Phillips at: dphillips@esm.rochester.edu (585) 274 1450. Summer placement exams are being given on Friday, June 27th, 2008.

JAZZ GRADUATE STUDENTS:

Master Degree students in Jazz Performance (JCM) and Jazz Writing (JCW) must take the traditional music history exam, in addition to the jazz theory exams (for MM JCM students, the jazz theory exam is in lieu of the traditional music theory exam).

Doctoral Jazz students must take both traditional music theory and music history exams, in addition to jazz history and jazz theory exams.

UNDERGRADUATE PLACEMENT EXAMS

All entering undergraduate students are required to take a placement exam in music theory before registering.

PLEASE NOTE:

Students who are unable to take the placement examinations on the prescribed date may, with the permission of the chair of the Music Theory and Musicology departments, be able to take them after classes have begun. Those who follow this procedure will as a result, register late, miss class-sessions, and may find that space is no longer available in some classes.
