To Candidates for the Ph.D., Ed.D., D.M.A., and D.N.P. Degrees at the 159th Annual Commencement:

I would like to extend to you a cordial invitation to participate in your Commencement, the University's one hundred fifty-ninth, on Saturday, May 16, 2009.

The University's Doctoral Degree Commencement will be held at the Eastman Theatre. This ceremony is for students from The College of Arts, Sciences, and Engineering, Eastman School of Music, School of Medicine and Dentistry, Margaret Warner Graduate School of Education and Human Development, School of Nursing, and William E. Simon Graduate School of Business Administration. The May 16 event begins with a concert prelude at 9:00 a.m. The formal ceremony begins at 9:30 a.m. and should end at approximately 11:00 a.m. Following the Commencement ceremony, there will be a reception in the Cominsky Promenade on the second floor of the Eastman School of Music.

At Commencement, the President formally confers the degrees and presents the individual diplomas to each graduate, who is then presented with his or her doctoral hood. This event is intended to be a grand, ceremonial occasion consistent with the distinguished accomplishments of graduates who have earned the University's highest academic degrees. In addition, it is our hope that this memorable affair will be warm and personal and enable you and your guests not only to celebrate your achievements but also to meet faculty and fellow students with whom you have worked.

To participate in the Doctoral Commencement Ceremony, all candidates are required to rent or buy their University of Rochester regalia. The deadline for ordering caps and gowns is **April 6**. If you wish to purchase doctoral regalia, orders can be taken at any of the University Bookstores. Doctoral candidates that rent regalia will return full regalia and will not keep caps and tassels. **Note: If rental regalia is not returned by May 22, 2009, a fee equal to the replacement value of \$831.00 for doctoral regalia will be billed to you directly.** Any regalia returned after June 1, 2009 will not be accepted for credit to your account. All orders must be placed by Monday, April 6 to guarantee availability before your commencement ceremony.

The enclosed blue form is your participation response card. In order to participate in the ceremony, you MUST return your participation response card (the blue card) with your regalia order form. Both are to be turned in at any of the University Bookstores. These blue cards contain important information that will affect the success of the ceremony such as name pronunciation, line-up order, and awarded degree. You must arrive by 8:30 a.m. on the morning of the ceremony. Anyone arriving after 8:30 a.m. will be placed at the end of the line and will receive a blank diploma. This policy will be strictly enforced.

Tickets are not required for admission to the Saturday morning ceremony, although we do ask that you indicate on the blue response card the number of guests in your party so that we may plan accordingly. Seating is available in a reserved area for guests with special needs. Again, we ask that you notify us by indicating special needs on the blue response card. The deadline for return of this form is **April 6**.
