Seventeenth Annual Conference

The Society for Seventeenth-Century Music (SSCM) will hold its ninth annual Book/Scores/CD Exhibit on April 23-26, 2009 in conjunction with its fifteenth annual conference to be hosted by The Eastman School of Music in Rochester, NY. SSCM invites you to send selected print titles, music scores, CDs, videos or other advertising materials.

Description

The SSCM annual conference attracts music historians and performers interested in late Renaissance and Baroque music. Registration runs 75-100. The conference features a benefit Book/Score/CD Exhibit of materials on 17th-century music.

Vendors DO NOT ATTEND this exhibit; rather SSCM administers a display area for

(a) donated display copies, which are sold to conference attendees as a benefit to SSCM. The handling charge is **\$15** for the first single display item, and **\$5** each per additional title, up to a maximum charge of **\$50**. Publishers who display five or more individual titles are not charged for additional materials (b below).

(b) order forms, flyers, or other bulk display materials.
The charge is **\$15** per batch/stack; **\$5** for order forms/brochures included with display copies (a above), unless five or more display items are sent.

Unsold display copies are not returned but are donated to a local non-profit institution.

Display Items

- Commercially published books, musical editions, journals, sound, video and DVD recordings, software, proof copies, dummy jackets, CD liners, etc.
- Batches of order forms, advertising flyers, catalogues, etc.
- The Exhibit does not display unpublished or self-published print items.
- Multiple CD sales not for the benefit of SSCM must be negotiated separately.

Exhibit Services

- Supervision at all times the exhibit is open to the public
- Individual vendor signs posted by vendor items
- Front cover display for all single items in category (a).
- Portable CD player with headphones for CDs.
- Secure, centrally located exhibit area
- SSCM does not process orders for vendors.
