⁶ Neither additional primary nor any secondary lessons may be used as electives. All courses must be 200-, 400-, or 500-level registrations. Arts Leadership (ALC) courses do not count for elective credit unless cross-listed with another department (MUE 504 Prepare Future Music Faculty and JCM 261 Entrepreneurship in Music.) Electives can include up to a maximum of four (4) credits of ensembles + chamber music, which includes all CHB and ENS sections except Repertoire courses. Required ensemble courses are included in this 4-credit total. Electives may include no more than six (6) credits of non-music courses.

⁷ MHS 435 Concert Repertoire: Museum or Living Art? (1 credit) can also be counted toward the elective requirement.
