 - When you reach this page, choose the link for the appropriate level.
 - Use **TIMhomework** for the password.
 - Choose the appropriate tracks according to the homework sheet.
- Every student has a homework practice chart and a challenge sheet. Each week certain tracks will be assigned for listening or challenge work.
 - Your child should listen to the assigned tracks 3-5 times during the next week and should echo, respond with the missing syllables, or follow the assigned challenge.
 - A check mark indicates an echo assignment and a number indicates a challenge.
 - Tracks labeled with an (n) have patterns performed without syllables. Students should sing or speak back each pattern with syllables.
- Please avoid writing out patterns or syllables. Our goal is to develop and challenge our listening (aural) skills.
- When each assignment is completed, a parent/guardian should sign the form next to the date of the assignment.
- Please bring the practice chart to class every week.
- **Weekly practice is essential for successful music literacy development!**
