The student, in consultation with the advisor, will choose 2 additional hours of coursework depending on his/her background, needs, and interests. At least two hours of elective coursework must be from outside the JCM department. Elective courses must be numbered 200 or higher. Arts Leadership (ALC) courses do not count for elective credit unless cross-listed with another department. Neither primary nor secondary lessons maybe used as elective credit. Electives may include courses in music theory, composition, arranging, or other topics, as determined in consultation with the advisor.

Normally two years will be needed to complete the coursework. Candidates will take a jury (jazz) during the first graduate year. The graduation recital in the spring semester of the second year will include performance of written and improvised music that is determined by the student under the guidance of JCM faculty.

The candidate will complete a contemporary media project that in the end will result in a CD, video, website, CD ROM or some other media related product that demonstrates the student's talents and abilities, and could serve to help launch his/her career.
