Important things to remember:

Variations from the prescribed program of study should be approved in advance by the appropriate Eastman department and appropriate documentation must be on file in the Registrar's

Bachelor of Music students must complete eight semesters of full-time, college-level study earning no fewer than 120 credits. Students must be registered for 12 credits each semester to be considered full-time. Students who earn advanced standing in any subject must complete an equivalent number of optional elective credits toward their required total degree

Upon receipt of an official transcript, a maximum of six college-level credits with a grade of B- or better may be used as transfer credit after matriculation.

All Bachelor of Music students must complete FWS 121 plus 21 additional credits of Humanities & Sciences courses of at least 3 credits each. Any course over 4 credits must be approved by the Humanities Department Chair. In some majors (voice and theory), required language classes count toward this requirement.
