Minimum semester hours for this major: 139

- [1] Satisfactory completion of two years of piano study or the PCL 104 examination.
- [2] All students in this curriculum will present a full senior recital, which will include performance of at least one work written within the last forty years.
- [3] Registration for optional credit required only if the student is below the required 12 credits per semester. Students must earn a minimum of 139 credits to receive a B.M. degree AND must carry a minimum of 12 credits each semester.
- [4] A 3-credit music history or music theory course at or above the 200-level must be taken to fulfill the required music academic elective. It can be taken in either the fall or spring semester.
- [5] Students must pass IT 101, IT 102, and IT 115 before they will be permitted to register for German or French language classes.
- [6] Student must register for a total of 6 Opera Theatre Practicum credits during their time at Eastman; either 2 semesters of OP 230 or 1 semester of OP 230 and 1 semester of OP 232.
- [7] 2nd semester seniors may register for OP 232: ESM Opera Theatre Practicum (Scenes) only if they require the additional credits to fulfill their 6-credit opera practicum requirement. Students who have already completed 2 semesters of OP 230 may not register for OP 232.
- [8] Music History classes do not have to be taken together in chronological order. Students may begin to take MHS 120s starting their sophomore year. Students must complete MHS 121, 122 and 123 before enrolling in a 200 level MHS course.

<u>Important things to remember:</u>

Variations from the prescribed program of study should be approved in advance by the appropriate Eastman department and appropriate documentation must be on file in the Registrar's office.

Bachelor of Music students must complete **eight semesters of full-time**, college-level study earning no fewer than **120 credits**. Students must be registered for 12 credits each semester to be considered full-time. Students who earn advanced standing in any subject must complete an equivalent number of optional elective credits toward their required total degree credits.

Upon receipt of an official transcript, a maximum of six college-level credits with a grade of B- or better may be used as transfer credit after matriculation.

All Bachelor of Music students must complete FWS 121 plus 21 additional credits of Humanities & Sciences courses of at least 3 credits each. Any course over 4 credits must be approved by the Humanities Department Chair. In some majors (voice and theory), required language classes count toward this requirement.
