Piano Improvisation for a total of 2 units. Should a student choose to take ensemble for credit, the units will count toward the student's electives.

Audio and Music Engineering courses (AME) are offered through the River Campus at the University of Rochester. Student may replace AME 460 with an equivalent music technology course upon successful completion of a placement examination.

The student, in consultation with the advisor, will choose 2 additional hours of coursework depending on his/her background, needs, and interests. At least two hours of elective coursework must be from outside the JCM department. Elective courses must be numbered 200 or higher. Arts Leadership (ALC) courses do not count towards the required units for the degree. Neither primary nor secondary lessons maybe used as elective credit. Electives may include courses in music theory, composition, arranging, or other topics, as determined in consultation with the advisor. Should a student choose to take ensemble for credit, the units will count toward the student's electives.

MHS 435: Concert Repertoire may also be counted as an elective.

⁶ Normally two years will be needed to complete the coursework. The graduation recital in the spring semester of the second year will include performance of written music that is determined by the student under the guidance of CMFC faculty.

The candidate will complete a contemporary media project that in the end will result in a CD, video, website, CD ROM or some other media related product that demonstrates the student's talents and abilities, and could serve to help launch his/her career.
