3 TH 400 (Analytical Techniques) – Masters Students whose BM degrees were earned at Eastman are advised to take TH 401 rather than 400 for their masters' theory requirement unless they place into the 117-118 sequence. If they are required to take TH 117-118, then they should take TH 400 after successful completion of TH 118.

4 Students who choose to demonstrate lyric diction proficiency by examination or previous coursework are exempt from the course requirement, but must replace the unit(s) with elective credit.

5 Elective courses must be numbered 200 or higher. Arts Leadership (ALC) courses do not count towards the required units for the degree. Neither primary nor secondary lessons may be used for elective credit.

6 MHS 435: Concert Repertoire may also be counted toward elective credit.
