- [1] Jazz writing majors will take 4 semesters of JAZ 160 applied music lessons in their first two years. In their junior and senior year, they will take 4 semesters of JAZ 130 applied music lessons and JCM 211-214 Jazz Composition Lessons. JAZ 130 Applied Music and JCM 211-214 Jazz Composition together fulfill the BM degree requirement that undergraduates must complete eight semesters of primary applied lessons.
- [2] PCL 102 proficiency AND satisfactory completion of JCM 205: Functional Jazz Piano I & JCM 206: Functional Jazz Piano II is required to satisfy the Class Piano requirement. Pianists substitute PCL requirements with 8 units of music-based electives to be approved by JCM Department chairperson.
- [3] JCM 241 fulfills the required upper-level music theory or music history elective at or above the 200-level for this major.
- [4] JCM 200 assigned by audition
- [5] See Academic Policy Handbook for information concerning electives.
- [6] A jazz writing-skills recital will be given during the spring semester of the senior year. The recital will showcase compositions and arrangements created by the student, demonstrating a variety of historical and contemporary jazz styles.
- [7] Music History classes do not have to be taken together in chronological order. Students may begin to take MHS 120s starting their sophomore year. JCM majors are required to complete MHS 121 or 122, MHS 123 and MHS 123J. MHS 123J is a jazz-specific music history course offered every other year.

Important things to remember:

Variations from the prescribed program of study should be approved in advance by the appropriate Eastman department and appropriate documentation must be on file in the Registrar's office.

Bachelor of Music students must complete **eight semesters of full-time**, college-level study earning no fewer than **120 units**. Students must be registered for 12 units each semester to be considered full-time. Students who earn advanced standing in any subject must complete an equivalent number of optional elective units toward their required total degree units.

Upon receipt of an official transcript, a maximum of two college-level courses up to 8 units with a grade of B- or better may be used as **transfer unit** after matriculation.

All Bachelor of Music students must complete FWS 121 plus 20 additional units of Humanities & Sciences courses of at least 4 units each. Any course over 4 units must be approved by the Humanities Department Chair. In some majors (voice and theory), required language classes count toward this requirement.
