#### Minimum semester hours for this concentration: 146

- [1] MEI students may have 1 semester of large ensemble waived for full time student teaching and are not in the FORTE program, resulting in 14 units total of large ensemble credit. MEI students with guitar or keyboard primary participate in choral ensembles ENS 12X. Students in the FORTE program must complete 16 units of large ensemble. [2] MEI/JCM double majors must complete 8 semesters of JCM 200.
- [3] The student must enroll for 24 total units in Humanities/Sciences, including first year writing seminar. See the Academic Policy Handbook for details concerning electives.
- [4] Students who place into TH 100/105 will start the Theory sequence in fall of their first year and are not required to take TH 230. Students who place into TH 110/115 begin the Theory sequence in the spring of their first year and will continue through TH 230.
- [5] MEI/JCM double majors whose primary instrument is Drum Set must complete 4 semesters of PRC 130 in addition to primary applied lessons.
- [6] MEI students whose primary instrument is guitar or piano (non-JCM) are required to take an additional 8 units of secondary instrument applied study. [7] MEI/JCM double majors whose primary instrument is Piano must complete 4 semesters of lessons in a secondary area of applied study in winds, brass, or percussion. MEI/JCM double majors whose instrument is not piano complete 2 semesters of PCL 101/102 and 2 semesters of JCM 205/206 to satisfy the PCL requirement.
- [8] MTL 241 or MTL 242 will satisfy the voice class requirement.
- [9] Choose MTL 211, 212, or 213, resulting in 2 units. (MTL 211 and 213 offered in Fall only/MTL 212 offered in Spring only).
- [10] Choose ICM 201 or 202, resulting in 2 units.
- [11] MEI/JCM double majors substitute JCM 223 or JCM 241 for JCM 201/202 for this major.
- 12] Music History classes do not have to be taken together in chronological order. Students may begin to take MHS 120s starting their sophomore year. Students must complete MHS 121, 122, and 123 before enrolling in 200 level MHS course.
- [13] MTL 272 is not required for MEI students whose primary instrument are strings. As a result, string primaries require 145 units.
- [14] MEI/JCM double majors substitute JCM 224 for CMP 250 for this major.
