The total number of ensembles and/or chamber music units counted toward the degree may not exceed four (4). This restriction includes all ENS and CHB courses, required or elective, with the exception of repertoire courses (CHB 401, 403, ENS 450, 451, 452, 453, or 454). Neither primary nor secondary lessons may count toward electives.
