Students in the Master of Music in Jazz Studies and Contemporary Media (Writing) degree may use this checklist to complete a self-assessment of their degree progress. A student can log into UR Student and access their academic history in order to fill this document out to determine if they're on track to graduate or see what remaining requirements they have left. Students can schedule an appointment with the Associate Director of Graduate Advising and Services at any time to verify their degree progress and address any concerns or questions.

In order to graduate from the Eastman School of Music and the University of Rochester with this degree and major, a student must complete a minimum of 31 credits. Students are required to complete two consecutive semesters of full-time status (minimum of 9 units) to satisfy the residency requirement.

Elective courses must be numbered 200 or higher. Arts Leadership (ALC) courses do not count towards the required units for the degree. At least 2 units must be outside of the JCM department. Writing skills majors are encouraged to elect orchestration, composition for non-majors, woodwind/brass/percussion methodology, or advanced composition courses that will directly benefit their composing and arranging skills. A limit of four units of ensemble/chamber music courses may count for degree credit. Electives may include up to six (6) units of applied music study.
