Students in the Master of Music in Music Education (Instrumental Music Emphasis) degree may use this checklist to complete a self-assessment of their degree progress. Students can schedule an appointment with the Associate Director of Graduate Advising and Services at any time to verify their degree progress and address any concerns or questions.

In order to graduate from the Eastman School of Music and the University of Rochester with this degree and major, a student must complete a minimum of 40 credits. Students are required to complete two consecutive semesters of full-time status (minimum of 9 units) to satisfy the residency requirement.
