

**Master of Music****Performance and Literature – Voice****Advising Worksheet**

Students in the Master of Music in Performance and Literature (Voice) degree may use this checklist to complete a self-assessment of their degree progress. A student can log into UR Student and access their academic history in order to fill this document out to determine if they're on track to graduate or see what remaining requirements they have left. Students can schedule an appointment with the Associate Director of Graduate Advising and Services at any time to verify their degree progress and address any concerns or questions.

In order to graduate from the Eastman School of Music and the University of Rochester with this degree and major, a student must complete a minimum of 36 credits. Students are required to complete two consecutive semesters of full-time status (minimum of 9 units) to satisfy the residency requirement.

The following checklist lists out all of the requirements needed to earn a Master of Music in Performance and Literature (Voice).

* Voice students must demonstrate one year (two semesters) of proficiency in Elementary Italian (with a grade of "B" or higher), as well as one semester of study in either Elementary French or German (with a grade of "B" or higher). Upon matriculation, student transcripts will be evaluated by the Associate Director of Graduate Advising and Services for evidence of foreign-language study. If the transcript indicates a lack of Italian 101+102 (IT 102 with a minimum grade of B or higher) and either French or German 101 with the minimum grade of B, the student will be required to take Italian 101 and 102 and a semester (101) of either French or German and earn a minimum grade B in each course.

<sup>2</sup> Students have the option of registering for unit and counting the unit towards elective unit. This requirement will be waived for students who received a bachelor's degree from Eastman.

<sup>3</sup> Elective courses must be numbered 200 or higher. Arts Leadership (ALC) courses do not count towards the required units for the degree. The total number of ensembles and/or chamber music units counted toward the degree may not exceed four (4). This restriction includes all ENS and CHB courses, required or elective, with the exception of repertoire courses (CHB 401, 403, ENS 450, 451, 452, 453, or 454). Neither primary nor secondary lessons may count toward electives.
