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

## **Biographical Sketch**

Will Gay Bottje (1925–2018) was an American composer known for his prolific output and work with electronic music. Born in Grand Rapids, Michigan, on June 30, 1925, he went on to study at Julliard, where he received a diploma (1944), a bachelor's degree in flute performance (1947), and a master's degree in composition (1948). Immediately after his graduation from Juilliard, Bottje spent some years working as a freelance flutist, teacher, and conductor in western Michigan. In 1952, he was awarded a Fulbright scholarship, which he used to study composition with Henk Badings in the Netherlands and Nadia Boulanger in Paris. After returning to the US, he enrolled in the doctoral program at the Eastman School of Music, where he studied composition with Bernard Rogers and Howard Hanson as well as conducting with Paul White and flute with

Joseph Mariano. He completed the degree in 1955, receiving one of the first Doctorate of Musical Arts degrees in the country and the first such degree from Eastman.

Dr. Bottje taught briefly at the University of Mississippi (1955–1957) before securing a position at Southern Illinois University as a professor of theory and composition. During his tenure, he founded the school's electronic music studio (1965). In 1962–1963, during a sabbatical, he returned to the Netherlands to study electronic music with Henk Badings at the University of Utrecht's electronic music studio. He retired to Grand Rapids, MI, in 1981. After his retirement, he stayed active composing and revising old works as well. Additionally, he worked as an adjunct instructor at Grand Valley State University, where he also established an electronic music studio.

Dr. Bottje passed away on January 7, 2018. He was survived by his wife Joyce, also a flutist and graduate of Juilliard, and their three children.

## **Provenance**

Dr. Bottje began to deposit his original works at the Sibley Music Library in 1997, and continued sending regular deposits of scores and, later, recordings through 2012.

#### **Scope and Content**

The Will Gay Bottje Collection is comprised of musical scores and parts as well as CD recordings of the composer's works. The compositions represented here are among Dr. Bottje's more conventional pieces, and most were revised by the composer and set using music notation software in the 1990s and 2000s.

#### Restrictions.

There are no restrictions to accessing this collection, and blanket permission to photocopy is on file.

#### **Associations**

The Will Gay Bottje Collection represents one among RTWSC's continually growing corpus of collections comprising the professional papers of graduate composers of the Eastman School of Music. This body of collections includes the papers of Wayne Barlow (BM 1934, MM 1935, PhD 1937), Gordon Binkerd (MM 1941), John La Montaine (BM 1942), William Bergsma (BA 1942, MM 1943), Eugene Kurtz (BM 1947, MM 1949), Donald White (MM 1947, PhD 1952), Louis Mennini (BM 1947, MM 1948, DMA 1961), P. Peter Sacco (MM 1954, DMA 1959), and Louis Angelini (MM 1960, PhD 1968), among numerous others.

## **DESCRIPTION OF SERIES**

## **Series 1: Scores**

This series consists of original compositions by William Gay Bottje. The majority of the compositions are printouts of scores and parts produced using music notation software (e.g., Encore) and appear to have been submitted to the American Composers Alliance (ACA) for distribution and management. Some works are represented by complete scores with parts, while others are represented by scores only. The works have been arranged in alphabetical order by title.

## **Series 2: Sound Recordings**

This series is comprised of 25 CDs with recordings of William Gay Bottje's compositions, most of which are self-produced. The CDs are numbered, presumably according to Bottje's own organization, and that order has been preserved here.
