ABOUT THE ARTIST

Weijun was born in Shanghai, China, and was five years old when he started studying piano. When he was eight years old, he moved to the United States and has studied with Alla Kuznetsov at ECMS since then.

He has taken part in several competitions and won various awards including 1st place in the junior All-Star competition and the David Hochstein Recital Competition and performed with the Rochester Philharmonic Orchestra as a winner of the RPL Young Artist competition. He was also invited to play at the NYSSMA piano conference.

Currently, Weijun is attending Pittsford Sutherland High School, where he plays in the orchestra directed by Tammy Keller and has volunteered in playing for school musicals. He is co-president of his school's Tri-M music chapter, which expands connections with the community around Pittsford through music. He has regularly volunteered his time after school, accompanying the Thornell Road Elementary School choir during rehearsals and concerts. He also plays in a piano trio at ECMS coached by Yifei Li. Weijun plans to study Computer Science and Music at Brown University.
