- 1. Application Form: Complete this form.
- **2. Personal Statement:** In a statement of 500 words explain your interest in this program, career goals, past teaching experiences, and your plan of action for completing the program requirements.
- **3.** Letters of recommendation: Submit <u>two</u> letters of recommendation, with at least one being from a college professor who has observed your teaching.
- 4. College transcript(s): Include all college transcripts (must be original).
- 5. Interview: You will be asked to interview after submitting all application materials.
