THE CERTIFICATE OF ACHIEVEMENT IN CHAMBER MUSIC

This Certificate of Achievement in Chamber music offers a course of study for current Eastman students interested in gaining additional skills in chamber music performance, public speaking, engaging audiences of all ages, entrepreneurial thinking, grant writing, and concert production. The goal of this certificate program is for students to be able to successfully launch and self-run a chamber music ensemble upon graduation. It is the hope that the student will emerge as a professional small ensemble player ready to contribute to rural or urban life by creating performance and educational opportunities, and discovering ways to use their art to make a difference in the community. The Certificate of Achievement in Chamber Music is open to all ESM students, both undergraduate and graduate.

Admission

Students must apply as a pre-formed group, with a history of working together. Only groups of 3 or more players will be eligible, with the exception of piano duos and some guitar groups on a case-by-case basis.

The application requires the completion of the attached form, a letter of recommendation from a chamber music coach, and a live audition as a group. Students must complete all degree requirements in CHB before applying for the certificate (Exception: Guitar majors can apply after 2 years of CHB).
