

THE CERTIFICATE OF ADVANCED ACHIEVEMENT IN ETHNOMUSICOLOGY

The Advanced Certificate of Achievement in Ethnomusicology (17-20 credits) recognizes the satisfactory completion of a set of courses related to world music and ethnomusicology. Most of the requirements can be easily integrated into your existing program of study.

REQUIREMENTS FOR PROGRAM (17-20 credits)

ADMISSIONS PROCEDURES

You must submit this application form with a cover letter. You must submit this by the beginning of your final year of degree studies. The cover letter must include a personal statement explaining:

1. Your interest in the Advanced Certificate of Achievement in Ethnomusicology
2. Steps you have taken so far to fulfill the requirements of this program
3. A plan of study showing how you will complete the requirements

Upon admission to the Advanced Certificate of Achievement Program, you will be assigned a faculty advisor who will monitor your progress through the requirements.
